R.N./CASE MANAGER – INFECTIOUS DISEASE

The Sangamon County Department of Public Health is seeking applicants to perform nursing duties primarily in the Infectious Disease and Immunization Programs.

Experience with Infectious Disease investigation is preferred. The successful candidate will perform a variety of duties including completion of epidemiological investigations on reportable communicable diseases; monitoring of clients with tuberculosis (TB) for medication and medical follow-up compliance, including home visits; assisting with TB testing; and administering flu vaccinations. Applicants must have the ability to communicate and interact with diverse families/communities and on rare occasions or in the event of a public health emergency, may be required to work evening and/or weekend clinics. Excellent communication skills, dependability, phone etiquette, a cheerful and professional personality, data input skills, experience with Word and Excel programs, and ability to multi-task are all important and necessary skills for this position.

Requires a current State of Illinois registered nursing license in good standing, a valid Class D Illinois Driver's License, use of personal automobile and proof of auto insurance. Applicants must be a resident of Sangamon County or be willing to move into the County within 6 months of employment.
