The Sangamon County Department of Public Health is seeking applicants to perform duties primarily in the Well Child, Immunization, and STD Clinics while maintaining compliance with established standards and procedures. This position requires a current State of Illinois registered nursing license in good standing, a valid Class D Illinois Driver's License, use of personal automobile and proof of auto insurance. Applicants must be a resident of Sangamon County or be willing to move into the County within 6 months of employment. Applicant must have the ability to work at least 1 late day (7:00 p.m.). On rare occasions, in the event of a public health emergency, this position may be required to work evening and/or weekend clinics as assigned.
