The Sangamon County Department of Public Health is seeking applicants to perform duties primarily in the WIC and Family Case Management Programs. The WIC/FCM nurse promotes positive health outcomes for participants through nutritional assessment, breastfeeding promotion/support, and program referrals. Duties include home visits and case management of social issues. This position requires a current State of Illinois registered nursing license in good standing, a valid Class D Illinois Driver's License, use of personal automobile and proof of auto insurance. On rare occasions, in the event of a public health emergency, this position may be required to work evening and/or weekend clinics as assigned. Must be a Sangamon County resident or be willing to move within the County within six months of employment.
