

COVID-19 Public Testing Sites for Sangamon County area residents

- **Contact your health insurance provider to learn about what they cover before making an appointment.**
- **Insurance information will be requested; out of network service provisions may apply.**
- **You can get a COVID-19 test for no cost at an IDPH testing location.**
- **COVID-19 testing and treatment is covered by Medicaid.**
- **COVID-19 testing is covered for uninsured Illinois residents regardless of citizenship and immigration status through the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH).**

Walgreens (3 years of age and older) NO CHARGE TO PATIENT, SYMPTOMS NOT REQUIRED; Perform the nasal swab yourself under the direction of a pharmacy team member. Patients ages 3-18 will need a parent or legal guardian while they self-administer the COVID-19 test. Schedule appointment at: <https://www.walgreens.com/findcare/covid19/testing>

CVS (3 years of age and older) IF EXPOSED OR HAVE SYMPTOMS THEN NO COST TO PATIENT; TRAVEL AND ASYMPTOMATIC COST \$139; Patient or Patient's Assistant performs nasal swab. Schedule appointment at <https://www.cvs.com/minuteclinic> or 217-522-6596 for automated agent.

UIS COVID-19 saliva testing site is now offering FREE TESTS to the public (non-symptomatic individuals who are not isolating due to COVID-19) in partnership with SHIELD Illinois, Results are sent directly to each individual tester's (or their guardian's) online SHIELD portal within 12-18 hours of testing. for community visitors. Persons with symptoms may be tested and evaluated at ExpressCare locations, ExpressCare telehealth, Memorial Physician Services primary care (in person and telehealth) and also Memorial Drive thru testing (4th street and 6th street locations with a physician order. Persons without symptoms that need testing for travel may walk in for testing at any ExpressCare location or obtain testing at a drive-through location with a physician order. There is a \$100 charge. A COVID-19 PCR result will be emailed within 24 hours.

HSHS Medical Group Drive Thru

Have to have symptoms, been exposed to COVID-19, or need a return-to-work or school test; testing under these conditions is covered by the federal CARES Act (no cost to patient.) Online registration and scheduling is required at <https://hshsmgcovidtesting.org/>

Springfield Clinic

Must be seen at Urgent Care or through primary care physician referral; see <https://www.springfieldclinic.com/driveuplabs> for more information or call 217-528-7541 extension 18258.

Hy-Vee Stay-In-Car Testing (PRIVATE PAY ONLY)

Antigen tests are offered at Hy-Vee, 2115 S. MacArthur Blvd, Springfield; the cost is \$129 and must be paid by credit or debit card (billing insurance is not available.) Testing is available to patients who are symptomatic and patients who are asymptomatic with a known or reported exposure in the last 14

days. Test results are available in as little as 1-2 hours. Children must be 6 years of age or older.

Interested individual would need to register and make an appointment.

COVID Clinic – located at White Oaks mall near Dick’s Sporting Goods (behind Panda Express)

Expedited COVID-19 PCR test available with results in 1-2 days. Rapid testing for travel and other purposes is available at patient expense. All services may be submitted to health insurance; insurance network coverage policies will apply. Testing and physician orders for uninsured patients covered by the federal CARES act.
